Contractions

- are a shorter way of saying what you need to say
- don't forget the apostrophe

<p>NOT</p> <p>can + not = can't are + not = aren't is + not = isn't was + not = wasn't did + not = didn't will + not = won't</p>	<p>would + not = wouldn't should + not = shouldn't could + not = couldn't were + not = weren't do + not = don't does + not = doesn't</p>
<p>WILL</p> <p>she + will = she'll he + will = he'll we + will = we'll</p>	<p>you + will = you'll they + will = they'll I + will = I'll it + will = it'll</p>
<p>ARE</p> <p>we + are = we're you + are = you're</p>	<p>who + are = who're they + are = they're</p>
<p>WOULD</p> <p>I + would = I'd</p>	<p>she + would = she'd he + would = he'd</p>
<p>HAVE</p> <p>I + have = I've you + have = you've</p>	<p>they + have = they've we + have = we've</p>
<p>IS</p> <p>she + is = she's what + is = what's that + is = that's</p>	<p>who + is = who's he + is = he's it + is = it's where + is = where's</p>
